- **RESERVED PARKING & CAMPING FEES:**
  - \$65.00 **Lines C-D RV & Trailer Hook-up** for the WEEKEND (32ft Spot with Electric & Water)
  - \$85.00 **Lines A-B RV & Trailer Hook-up** for the WEEKEND (32ft Spot with Electric & Water)
  - \$45.00 Dry Camping Fee for the WEEKEND
  - \$100.00 **A – Reserved A Parking** (Limited 10 Spots - 60'x14')
  - \$50.00 **B – Reserved B Parking** (Limited 17 Spots - 60'x14')
  - \$50.00 **C – Reserved C Parking** (Limited 8 Spots - 40'x18')
  - \$50.00 **D – Reserved D Parking** (Horse Arena Limited 24 Spots - 40'x18')
  - \$50.00 **E – Reserved E Parking** (Limited 8 Spots - 14'wide)

**Pens and tie-outs are available.** First come, first serve for pens. If you use a Pen or tie-stall you MUST CLEAN IT before leaving the fairgrounds. Bedding and CLEAN-UP is the *exhibitor's responsibility*. Bring your shovels and wheelbarrows to remove bedding, fitting trash & manure to designated areas or roll-off dumpster. Reminder, no manure in trash cans.

**SHOW REGISTRATION & WEIGH-IN Details:** Exhibitors must check-in & receive a show number in the Check-in Building BEFORE going to the scale to be weighed. **Show Numbers** must be visibly worn in the show ring.

**BREEDING ANIMALS:** All REGISTERED Breeding Animals must show proof of breed registration and lease agreement (if applicable) to the show officials during check-in before the animal will be officially entered. If not, they will be moved to the crossbred class and shown by weight (they will need to be weighed).

**QUIZ BOWL CONTEST** will be held both Saturday and Sunday. The contest is free. Champion and Reserve Champion Divisions winners will be awarded each day.
